

Protect your dog — and yourself — from this potentially deadly disease



Affects multiple species Leptospirosis is a bacterial disease that spreads through urine and

can infect wildlife, farm animals, rodents, dogs, and humans.



Bacteria can survive in water or soil for weeks or months Dogs usually become infected by drinking, swimming, or walking through contaminated water.





Early treatment is key Antibiotics are highly effective if they're given early. Without treatment, the disease can cause severe kidney or liver damage and may be fatal.



Reduce the risk

Getting your dog vaccinated against the disease and keeping your dog away from standing water are the best ways to protect against the disease.
